Procedures performed in hospital

BOOKING —

You have been booked at:

Please fill in the admission form and forward it to the hospital prior to admission. Your chosen hospital will contact you to advise you of what time you should arrive at the hospital.

SURGICAL FEES —

You will have a quotation for the proposed services. Payment is expected three days prior to surgery to confirm your surgery. You will be contacted to confirm your surgery and arrange payment. You can pay by direct deposit, (details below) with credit card over the phone or bring payment to the rooms prior to surgery. There will also be fees charged by the hospital for the hospital stay and a charge by the anaesthetist for the anaesthetic. Please contact the hospital and the anaesthetist for further details regarding these fees quoting the item numbers on your quotation.

FASTING —

If surgery is in the morning DO NOT eat or drink anything at all from midnight, the night before surgery.

If surgery is in the afternoon DO NOT eat or drink anything after 07:30 on the day of your operation. You may have a light breakfast, tea and toast, but dairy products should be avoided.

MEDICATION —

Take normal medication as usual unless otherwise specified. Avoid aspirin for pain control for 7 days before the operation because of the risk of bleeding.

ANAESTHETIST —

A specialist anaesthetist will medically evaluate you prior to surgery and will administer the anaesthetic.

AFTER SURGERY —

Rest and softer foods will be necessary for commonly a week after surgery depending on your circumstances. You will be give post-operative instructions and a medical certificate at the time of surgery.



Procedures performed in rooms

You may according to your individual situation have a procedure with local anaesthesia in the rooms. All procedures are carried out in accordance with guidelines for asepsis and sterile technique.

Take normal medications as usual unless otherwise specified. Avoid aspirin for pain control for 7 days before the operation, because of risk of bleeding.

SURGICAL FEES —

You will have a quotation for the proposed services. Payment is expected by the day of surgery. You will be given a detailed account/receipt suitable for claiming. With this account you can then claim rebate with appropriate private dental health insurance, or certain procedures can be claimed with Medicare.

MEDICATION —

Take normal medication as usual unless otherwise specified. Avoid aspirin for pain control for 7 days before the operation because of the risk of bleeding.

REST —

Rest and softer foods will be necessary for a few days after surgery depending on your circumstances. You will be given specific post-operative instructions and a medical certificate at the time of surgery.

MOUTHRINSING —

Delay rinsing after an extraction for 24 hours to allow time for the socket to begin healing. After 24 hours rinse frequently to prevent infection occurring from material lodging in the socket.
